2. Tenders have been invited through ICB from all the eligible bidders.

3. Initiating the discussion, Mr. V. Sudhakara Rao welcomed the participants. It was explained that purpose of Pre-bid meet is to educate the bidders regarding various important provisions of the bidding documents and also to clarify any queries that the bidders may have regarding commercial or technical issues in the subject bidding documents.

4 Queries have been raised by the prospective bidders which are clarified as follows:-

1	<p>Clause BDS/ITB 37.1 50% increase in originally specified quantity will significantly overburden the production activities. Therefore we propose that the “ Purchaser can increase the quantity of goods and services originally specified :by 20% , in due consultation with the suppliers and with adequate increase in the delivery lead times”</p>	<p>No change is considered. Conditions as per bid document shall prevail.</p>
2	<p>Schedule of Requirement As longer lead times are involved in procurement of Raw Material & Packing Material after receipt of order from Purchaser, we propose that “1st Tranche delivery, should be within 4 months from NOA, 2nd tranche delivery should be 5-7 months from NOA and 3rd tranche delivery should be within 7-9 months from NOA for the originally specified quantity.”</p>	<p>No change is considered. Conditions as per bid document shall prevail.</p>
3	<p>Clause SCC/ GCC 9, Technical Specifications Currently Pre-shipment inspection is performed by External agencies before every shipment; sampling is done from each batch and sent for external lab testing. Being a WHO Prequalified supplier, we propose that “Pre-shipment Inspection/sampling/Testing need not be for all shipments and can be on randomized basis, which is followed by WHO/GDF monitoring program.</p>	<p>No change is considered. Conditions as per bid document shall prevail.</p>
4	<p>Clause SCC/GCC 9, Technical Specifications Post Pre-shipment inspection, the External Lab takes very long time to analyze each individual drug batch. Therefore being a WHO Prequalified supplier and to facilitate timely deliveries, we propose that “Purchaser should allow dispatch of goods in parallel to testing, at supplier’s own risk.”</p>	<p>No change is considered. Conditions as per bid document shall prevail.</p>
